

## General rules

- Participants are admitted to perform in one category only. There is no lower age limit for the professional level competition, but it is not possible to perform in both professional level competition and youth competition (age groups I-V)
- The decisions of the jury are final.
- All performances are open to the public.
- The organization is authorized to make photographs, live broadcasts and audio/video recordings of the competition to document the competition and for publicity purposes. No claims for reimbursement for participants may arise from that.
- The application fee is **50 EUR** for age groups I-V and **80 EUR** for professional level competition. **The application fee is non-refundable** and can only be returned if the competition is cancelled.
- The organization reserves the right to make changes in competition schedule. However, the dates of the competition can not be changed.
- By sending an application, participant agrees with all the general and specific rules.

## Specific rules for youth competition (age groups I-V)

- Participants will perform in alphabetical order
- Participants will be informed about the approximate schedule after the competition deadline
- Participants must not exceed the maximum age permitted for their age group before 6th of April 2020
- Participants are not admitted to perform in lower or higher age groups than their actual age
- The jury can award three main prizes. The jury reserves the right not to award certain prizes, as well as to award shared prizes and special prizes. Between all competitors of age groups I-V, a GRAND PRIX (Stomvi trumpet) will be awarded.
- The programme can not be changed after the application deadline

## Specific rules for professional level competition

- Participants must not exceed 35 years of age before 5th of April 2020.
- **The jury** will be composed of 5 internationally renowned concertists and professors from different countries. The jury can award three main prizes and reserves the right not to award certain prizes, as well as to award shared prizes and special prizes.
- **1st prize is a Stomvi trumpet (Titan model).** The exact type of the trumpet will be chosen by the winner. **The 2nd prize** is cash in amount of **800 EUR** and the **3rd prize** in amount of **500 EUR**.
- **Performance order** will be determined by drawing of lots on 2nd of April at 21:00. The performances will be held in alphabetical order, beginning with the letter drawn. The order will be valid for both rounds. Participants who are not able/do not wish to be present at the drawing should confirm their participation by e-mail ([trumpet.talents@gmail.com](mailto:trumpet.talents@gmail.com)) by 2nd of April at 18:00 (Estonian time), at the latest. In this case, they will be notified their approximate performance time after the drawing by e-mail.
- **The second round will be divided** in two parts, with a short intermission. In the first part all the finalists will perform the Trumpet Concerto by J. Haydn, and in the second part the optional piece.
- Participants are required to be present at the competition venue at least 30 min. before their expected performance time.
- The **programme** can not be changed after the application deadline.
- Participants can bring their own **accompanist** or play with a highly qualified pianist provided by the competition. In the latter case, rehearsal of 1h can be arranged upon request for a fee of 25 eur. A request for pianist should be sent together with the application.
